Fitness/Recreation

Meyer Recreation Barn

The goal of the fitness center is to expand recreational and fitness opportunities available to the Bennington community. The Meyer Recreation Barn is open to all faculty, staff, and students. Members are allowed to bring one guest with them but the member must accompany them. All guests will be asked to fill out a liability waiver before using any of the equipment. The facility houses an aerobics room, climbing wall, free weights, sauna and restrooms. The exercise equipment includes selectorized/cable, cardiovascular, and plate loaded machines. The Office of Student Life provides oversight of the facility. Only children 14 years or older who are accompanied by a parent or guardian with a valid identification card are permitted into the Meyer Recreation Barn to use any equipment in the facility, including the Climbing Wall.

General Guidelines for Use

- The Recreation Barn is open to all members of the Bennington College community, who must present a College ID to use the facility. ID applications are available through the Office of Student Life, and IDs are made through Dining Services.
- Appropriate athletic attire, shirts and shoes are required. Black-soled shoes are not permitted in the aerobics room.
- Sports equipment, including basketballs, soccer balls, baseball/softball equipment, bocce sets, tennis equipment, Frisbees, and badminton sets may be checked out from the facility. Persons wishing to borrow equipment must fill out an Equipment Checkout Form. Equipment must be returned within 24 hours of the checkout time. If equipment is lost, damaged, or returned late, borrowing privileges will be revoked, and the borrower will be billed for the cost of equipment.
- Sports equipment, including basketballs, soccer balls, baseball/softball equipment, bocce sets, tennis equipment, Frisbees, and badminton sets may be checked out from the facility. Persons wishing to borrow equipment must fill out an Equipment Checkout Form. Equipment must be returned within 24 hours of the checkout time. If equipment is lost, damaged, or returned late, borrowing privileges will be revoked, and the borrower will be billed for the cost of equipment.
- Outdoor equipment is also available for rental for local personal trips. This equipment includes sleeping bags and pads, backpacks, tents, snowshoes, and cross-country skis. There is a rental fee for each item, which must be paid prior to use. Those renting equipment are responsible for its appropriate use and returning the items in good condition at the set return time. To rent equipment, contact the Office of Student Life.
- Anyone who does not comply with these guidelines may have his/her privilege to use the facility and/or equipment revoked.

Monitors

Students are employed as monitors and are responsible for ensuring proper equipment and facility use. In case of an emergency, they will call Security. They are not employed or certified as "personal trainers."

Use of Equipment

Each user of mechanized and/or weight equipment must be trained in its proper use by a monitor. If it appears that a piece of equipment is not being used properly, either the use must be discontinued or the user must receive proper training. Any person lifting free weights must use collars on the weight bars and return the weights to the racks. No free weights may leave the facility.

Climbing Wall

The Climbing Wall is an indoor rock climbing facility where climbers of all abilities are welcome. The Climbing Wall is open for climbing Sunday – Thursday 7pm – 9pm, throughout the academic year except during the Winter (FWT) and Summer breaks. Bouldering on the wall is allowed any time the Meyer Recreation Barn is open. Anyone using the climbing wall must first fill out a liability waiver form and safety policies form. The bouldering line indicates the height to which someone may climb (with shoulders below the line) without using ropes, however a spotter is recommended for safety purposes. Individuals who have passed the belay certification test are eligible to belay other climbers. Monitors are available to help individuals prepare for the certification test, and perform the test during open hours.

Aerobics Room

This room may be reserved for non-academic use through Student Life. The walls are mirrored and the space may be used for a variety of activities, such as student athletic clubs.

Sauna

Manufacturer's guidelines for use are posted and must be followed. For sanitary and public health reasons, clothing or covering must be worn. Monitors will be responsible for checking the sauna.

Outdoor Recreation Activities on Campus

Outdoor recreation facilities include three tennis courts, a basketball court, and a soccer field. Hiking is available on the College's Blue Trail, which winds through the wooded parts of campus and connects to several good trails throughout the region. The trailhead is located behind the Davis Alumni House.

The Office of Student Life can provide information on racquet and health clubs in the area, including information on the Bennington Recreation Center, a local facility that offers an indoor swimming pool. Staff may be eligible for a discounted rate at the Bennington Recreation Center. Please inquire at that facility for discount rates.
