The Fund offers small grants for Bennington College student projects in the Village of North Bennington.

Projects may be in the arts, sciences, social sciences or humanities, or may involve special events. The only eligibility requirement is that the work engages students in the Village, preferably interacting with residents. Funds are limited, and the maximum individual grant will be \$250 to cover expenses and any necessary stipends.

Applications are accepted by April 15 and December 1st; students will be notified by May 1st and December 15. Two grants per year will be offered, one in each academic term.
