## International Student Certification of Finances Guidelines

Please read prior to completing this form.

The purpose of the *Certification of Finances* is to help colleges and universities obtain complete and accurate information about the funds available to international applicants who want to study in the United States. Strict government regulations, rising educational costs, and economic conditions have made verification of financial resources of international applicants essential. Institutions do not have the option of deciding whether or not to verify the financial resources of their international applicants; financial verification must be made prior to institutional issuance of Certificates of Eligibility (Form I-20 or IAP-66).

The form is designed to standardize financial information provided by applicants to colleges, universities, and United States consuls. By completing and returning the form to the college/university requiring it, an applicant, if admitted, may obtain that college's authorization and issuance of a Certificate of Eligibility (Form I-20 or IAP-66). If parents and/or sponsors are unable to obtain a bank official's verification, it is recommended that institutions forward a copy of the Foreign Student Financial Aid Application to the family for completion. The institution should attach a copy of the Certification to the Certificate of Eligibility. United States consuls scrutinize the statements of financial resources given by nonimmigrant visa applicants. The Certification will help such officials make their decisions and expedite visa issuance.

Return this form directly to the college that provided or requested it. Do not send it to the College Scholarship Service® or International Education at the College Board.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE COF

These instructions will guide students and their families in completing the Certificate of Finances (COF). They are not intended to give instructions on every section of the COF, but only on those sections that may need more explanation.

- Please print your full name as it appears in your passport.
   Please tell us the different sources of funding you are using to finance your education.
- 2. If you have some personal funds (Section 8a), please tell us the name of the bank and the amount you will have the first year and how much you project to have in the remaining years. Make sure to also attach any bank statements that confirm the availability of funds.
- 3. If your parents are providing you with financial support (Section 8b), please indicate the amount they will provide in the first year and the remaining years. They will also need to provide any documentation (bank statements, letter from employer confirming salary, etc.) that confirms the availability of funds. If possible, a bank official should sign the COF.
- 4. If you are receiving financial support from other sources (relatives, friends, organizations, etc.), please indicate the amount of support they will provide the first year as well as the remaining years. Please have them sign the form. (Section 8c)
- 5. Don't forget to sign the form acknowledging that the information you have provided is accurate and complete, and that you understand that any misrepresentation may be cause for denying or revoking admission.

Please Review the COF figures on the attached letter for ease of completion. We have color coded the correct amounts for ease. Your first year of attendance is in vellow and years 2-4 is in green.
