OUTSIDE SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

1. What is an outside scholarship?

These funds are grants or scholarships not awarded through the financial aid office at Bennington College. *Pell Grants, state grants, 529 plan (state prepaid tuition plan or tuition savings plan) benefits, and employee tuition benefits are not considered outside scholarships.*

2. How does Bennington treat outside scholarships?

By federal regulation, any outside scholarship aid must be reflected in the student's financial aid package. Recipients should be in touch with the Financial Aid Office as soon as they receive scholarship notification.

For students at Bennington (who are US citizens or eligible non-citizens), outside scholarship funds awarded to a need-based aid recipient will replace, in order:

- 1. any "unmet need" as determined using the federal aid eligibility calculation;
- 2. any federal unsubsidized or subsidized student loan funds in the financial aid award
- 3. Bennington Grant

"Unmet need" is part of the education cost borne by the family. Technically, it's the amount by which a student's education costs for the year (after financial aid) exceed the amount the student (and family) can pay per the FAFSA calculation.

Students who want outside scholarship funds to replace family contribution (family payment) should be aware that when a federal *subsidized* student loan is replaced by scholarship funds, the student can request the same amount of federal *unsubsidized* student loan, effectively reducing family contribution.

For example, a student is awarded an outside scholarship of \$2500 for the year. His federally-calculated family contribution is \$9000, but his college costs for the year are \$11,000. He uses the \$2500 scholarship to replace both the \$2000 difference (which is his "unmet need") and to replace \$500 of his federal *subsidized* student loan. He then requests \$500 in federal *unsubsidized* student loan funds, so in effect, the outside scholarship has replaced \$2500 of the education costs he and his family would pay.

If a scholarship organization has specific awarding requirements, Bennington's Financial Aid Office will try to work with the organization to ensure that the student can collect the scholarship assistance.

3. How does Bennington treat employee tuition benefits?

This resource replaces part of the Bennington Grant in a student's aid award.
