MIDDLEBURY LANGUAGE SCHOOLS LIEBOWITZ CENTENNIAL FELLOWSHIP NOMINATION

Bennington's partnership with the [Middlebury Language Schools](#) has made it possible for three Bennington students to receive Jessica K. and Ronald D. Liebowitz Centennial Fellowships to support enrollment in the summer 2022 Language Immersion Programs.

The Middlebury Language Schools offer programs in Abenaki, Arabic, Chinese, French, German, Hebrew, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Portuguese, Russian, and Spanish. Courses run for two, seven, or eight weeks at either the Middlebury or Bennington campus. For 2022, Arabic, Italian, and Portuguese will operate at Bennington College, while the remaining languages will be at Middlebury College.

These intensive learning environments offer the opportunity to significantly advance a student's learning through complete language immersion. Students who continue to study their chosen language at Bennington, if available, will be placed at the appropriate level of language study with the permission of the instructors.

Students who successfully complete the summer program will earn transfer credits: 3 credits for the two-week course, 9 credits for seven-week courses, or 12 credits for eight-week courses. Students should be in conversation with [Academic Services](#) to understand how transfer credits will be applied to their Bennington transcript.

Currently enrolled Bennington students studying in any discipline and in good academic and disciplinary standing are eligible. Funding priority will be given to students with an approved Plan and whose proposed language study complements the work of their Plan and/or career goals.

Scholarship funding and financial responsibilities

- This scholarship provides funding for **80%** of tuition fees, which *includes* room and board but *excludes* travel to and from programs, books, and personal expenses. **Applicants must demonstrate that they can meet tuition obligations** of \$690, \$2,183 or \$2,760 depending on the program, *in addition to* the cost of travel, personal expenses, and books.

Application Process

1. **Complete this nomination application.**
All nomination application materials must be emailed to [Jennifer Burg](#) by **December 13, 2021, at 9:00am**. A Bennington College committee will select students as nominees for the fellowship. The Middlebury Language Schools will select fellowship recipients from the nominees in February 2022.
2. **Complete the online [Application for Middlebury Language Schools Immersion Programs](#).**
The deadline is **December 15, 2021**. Use code WAIVERC to have the full application fee waived. Apply as soon as possible, as programs often fill quickly. Completing this application also places students into consideration for other scholarships and financial aid offered by Middlebury.
